Elohim Speaks to Us (Part 5)

Perspective: The Return from Egypt and the Geometry of the New Beginning

Central Theme: The ascent to the *Negev*, the separation of density (*Lot*) and wealth as a divine frequency.

2. Linguistic and Mathematical Analysis (Gematria)

The teaching reveals that the Hebrew words describe physical laws of the spirit.

A. The Number 8 Cycle (*Vayaal*)

- **Concept:** On leaving Egypt, the text says that Abraham "went up" (*Vayaal*).
- **Meaning:** The number 8 represents what is beyond nature (which is 7). It is a "new *Bereshit*". Abraham doesn't just travel geographically; he is jumping to a higher octave of consciousness after having passed the shadow test in Egypt.

B. Wealth as a Divine Name

- **Cabed (Heavy/Rich):** Abram's wealth is described as "Cabed".
- **Gematria:** The numerical value of this condition is connected with 26, which is the value of the name **YHVH**.
- **Conclusion:** Abram's wealth is not worldly; it is a manifestation of YHVH's frequency materialized on the physical plane to fulfill a spiritual purpose.

3. Spiritual Geography: Negev and Sodom

Location	Hebrew Meaning	Gematria / Connection	Spiritual Involvement
Negev	The South / The dry	55 (HaAdamah)	The place of replanting; where the soul replants its seed.
Sodom	Sodom	Loss of Murmur	A state of total disconnection from Ruach (spirit); purely biological life.

"Lot chooses the plain for its appearance, but spiritually he enters a state of 'Sodom,' where the breath of Elohim is not found by the density of matter." Lot has chosen the wrong path.

4. The Multidimensionality of Being

One of the most profound points of this installment is the vision of Elohim and man as beings that inhabit several planes at the same time:

1. **Multidimensional Elohim:** It is not a static entity. It can manifest itself in different "personalities" or roles (Father, Shepherd, King, Judge) simultaneously in different dimensions.
2. **Man as Reflection:** We also operate in multidimensionality. We have roles on the physical plane, but our "roots" and other versions of our identity are acting on spiritual planes. Understanding this removes dogma and opens the perception to the original "breath" of creation.

5. Final Conclusions

1. **The Restart is Necessary:** The exit from Egypt requires a "rise" (*Vayaal*). You cannot start a new cycle if you do not raise the vibration above the previous cycle (the step from 7 to 8).
2. **Wealth with Purpose:** Abundance in Abram's path is intrinsically tied to the name of YHVH. It is a tool of service, not an end for the ego (unlike the wealth received in Egypt).
3. **The Danger of Disconnection:** The Story of Lot warns against decisions based on physical sight. *Sodom represents success that lacks divine "breath," eventually leading to spiritual barrenness.*
4. **Toward a Spirituality Without Dogmas:** The study of Hebrew and Aramaic seeks to clear the lens through which we view Scripture, allowing the soul to identify its true position on the multidimensional map of Elohim.
