

In this lesson, we delve into the **geometry of spiritual ascent**, thresholds of light, and the divine protection of knowledge through the symbology of the sword.

Elohim Speaks to Us (Part 6)

Perspective: Decoding Spiritual DNA and Thresholds of Eternity

Central Theme: *Stations of Ascent (Massa)*, the true nature of the *Betulah* and the protective sword of light.

1. Structure of Chapters and Stations of the Journey

Title	Key Concepts
The Purpose of Olam	The transfer to another eternity; material wealth as a reflection of the well-being of the soul.
Masa: Las Jornadas	The seasons as levels of ascent. The cycle of 7 and the jump to 8.
Bethel and Bethulah	The connection between the "House of God" and the "Virgin" as containers of light.
Ai: The Thresholds	Reinterpretation of "Ai" as doors or passages to true life.
The Spinning Sword	The protection of the Tree of Life and exclusive access for the <i>Tzaddik</i> (righteous).

2. Decoding Spiritual Concepts

We use Hebrew linguistics to dismantle literal interpretations and reveal energy structures.

A. Masa (מַסָּא): The Spiritual Station

In Hebrew, Abram's "journeys" are not just physical journeys. Each **Masa** is a *training station*.

- **Mechanics of the Ascent:** Each level (Olam) has a cycle of seven stages. Upon reaching the end of seven, the soul experiences an ascent to a higher plane of light.
- **The Moedim:** It is suggested that there are 8 marked appointments (*Moedim*) for each plane, which serve as points of connection with the light of the upper level.

B. The Mystery of the Betulah (Virgin)

We review the review of these two concepts that come together at some point in their pronunciation.

- **Bethel (House of El):** The place where the divinity resides.
- **Betulah (Virgin):** Through gematria, it is explained that the "virgin" does not necessarily refer to a human woman on the biological plane, but to a **spiritual structure** (a "house" or shadow) designed to protect pure light without contaminating it.

The "Bethulah" is a higher plane of purity that allows the manifestation of the Messiah.

3. Thresholds and Protection: Ai and the Sword

Term	Decoded Meaning	Relationship with Yeshua
Ai (אֵי)	Threshold or Gate	It connects with the letter 17 (Pei), associated with the mouth/word and with Yeshua as the <i>Reshit</i> (reset).
The Sword (Cherev)	Swivel Protection	Composed of the letters <i>Shin</i> and <i>Tet</i> . It is the polarity that guards the way to the Tree of Life.
Tzaddik (Righteous)	The one who qualifies	Only the one who has been corrected can pierce the sword without being destroyed.

The Double Edge of Light

The sword that "turns" represents the polarity necessary in creation (Sun and Moon, give and receive). This sword does not seek to punish, but to **protect the light** from those who do not have the vessel or the spiritual level necessary to contain it. It is present in Bereshit 13:4 when Abram invokes the name in the same place where the threshold is.

4. Key Findings

1. **Scripture as Software:** The Torah functions as an encrypted spiritual DNA. To read it literally is to stay on the surface; decoding it allows the soul to "re-program" itself for the ascent between worlds (*Olamot*).
2. **The Function of the "Shadow":** Both Bethel and Bethulah are necessary "shadows." The infinite light of Elohim cannot dwell directly in the physical without a container to dim and protect it.
3. **Identity of the Messiah:** We question traditional interpretations of Yeshua's genealogy, suggesting that his origin is from a higher plane and not merely biological-human, based on the nature of the heavenly *Bethulah*.
4. **Access to Life:** The path to the Tree of Life is open, but guarded. The study of Hebrew and the rectification of character are the tools that allow the believer *to be recognized by the "sword" as a Tzaddik* and thus cross the threshold of *Ai*.
