

Elohim Speaks to Us (Part 11)

Divine Genetics and Kingdom Decoding

This paper discusses the interconnection between Hebrew letters, numerical values, and spiritual genealogy that links Creation to the figure of Yeshua and the order of Melchizedek.

I. Methodology: The Language of Ruach

The teaching states that the biblical text is not just literature, but a **spiritual genetic code**. To access it, it is necessary to transcend the literal translation through three pillars:

Multilingual Analysis	Use of Hebrew and Aramaic to find the real etymological root.

II. The Codification of Yeshua in Creation

It is postulated that the name of **Yeshua** does not appear late in history, but appears from the first verse of the Torah.

Concept / Word	Valor Guematria	Reduction / Meaning
Yeshua (ישוע)	386	Frequency of salvation present at the origin.
HaShamayim (Heavens)	395	Reduced to 17 (Divine Connection).
HaErets (Earth)	296	Reduced to 17 (Material Manifestation).
The Number 17	---	It represents Teshuvah (Return to the origin).

Key Note: The number 17 acts as a bridge. In the context of Mark 1:15, the Teshuvah is the "fulfillment of the time" for man to return to the frequency of the heavens.

III. The Duality of Perception: The Mystery of Lot

Through the analysis of Bereshit 13:10, the drop in sensory perception is examined. Lot does not see spiritual reality, but an illusory "copy."

Table 3: The Paradox of the Number 16

Concept	Gematria	Reduction	Spiritual Meaning
Mashiach (Messiah)	358	16	Awareness of reality.
Nachash (Snake)	358	16	The consciousness of illusion.
KaErets Mitzrayim (like the land of Egypt)	691	16	The "narrow place" or world of illusions.

Conclusion of the excerpt: Lot chose the plain because his eyesight was conditioned by *Mitzrayim* (Egypt). Seeing the "garden" through the filter of Egypt, he chose the illusion of the serpent rather than the reality of the Messiah.

IV. The Priesthood and the Species of Melchizedek

The report differentiates the Levitical priesthood (human/temporal) from the order of Melchizedek (eternal/genetic).

- **Melchizedek Nature:** He does not define himself as an ordinary man, but as a **distinct "species"** that does not belong to any known loop.
- **Yeshua's Mission:** He acts as the High Priest who achieves the union of *HaShamayim* (Heavens) and *HaErets* (Earth): The Malkut.
- **Overcoming Adam:** While the "Adam" system (value 45) represents creation subject to cycles, Yeshua crosses these heavens to establish a new eternal system of life.

V. General conclusions

1. **Reality is Numerical:** The Hebrew Bible works as a software where numbers validate spiritual truth over traditional religious interpretations.
2. **The Illusion Trap:** The physical world (Egypt) is a copy that can confuse even the so-called (like Lot). The difference between the "Serpent" and the "Messiah" lies in the frequency with which the same energy is perceived (both add up to 358).
3. **The Return (Teshuvah):** Teshuvah is the act of tuning the consciousness to the number 17, returning to the original blueprint encoded in *Bereshit*.
4. **Higher Genetics:** The believer is called to transcend the genetics of Adam to enter the "species" of the Melchizedek priesthood. Yeshua transcended the heavens and therefore the loops could not stop Him.
